### Answers

#### Animal Number One

An Elephant! This piece of music was written nearly 135 years ago by the French composer Camille Saint-Saëns.



#### Animal Number Two

A dog! This is a piece by the American composer George Gershwin called 'Walking the Dog'. You can imagine the dog running around and chasing sticks.



#### Animal Number Three

A sheep! This is a tricky tune to guess because it sounds just like Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star.



#### Animal Number Four

If you guessed 'fish', you'd be right! This is a tune called 'The Trout' by Franz Schubert. In the piece, the piano plays rippling water sounds whilst the clarinet plays a jolly tune over the top.



### Animal Number Five

A bear! In this piece by Vitalij Neugasimov the piano plays lots of low, heavy notes to sound like a galumphing bear.



### Animal Number Six

A mouse! This is a jazzy version of *Three Blind Mice* called 'Three Blue Mice', written by Terence Greaves.



### Animal Number Seven

The swan! This is a famous, flowing piece by Camille Saint-Saëns. Just like Schubert's piece 'The Trout', the piano plays more rippling water sounds whilst the clarinet plays a lovely smooth tune, which is the swan gliding along the water.
