

DUCK MASK MAKING INSTRUCTIONS



What you'll need:

Card (if you're printing the mask at home)

Scissors

Pencils

Pens



Tape or pritt stick

String or elastic


TOP TIP: mark the back of your cut out pieces with the letters next to each piece



1. Start by colouring in your duck mask. You can use pencils pens or paint depending on what you have in your home
2. Once you've finished colouring your duck. Cut out template (a.) Cut out the inside of the eyes too by snipping a little hole in the centre and then cutting around the edge. Don't cut out the eye lids.
3. Cut along the dotted lines on the cheeks then fold your card to meet the black line next to it. Tape or glue in place. Cut off the unwanted card showing (see photo).
4. Cut out your feathers (b and c). Fold them down the centre and then cut along the dotted line and fold the one side on top of the other. If you like you can slip along the edge of your feathers and curl them in slightly with your fingers.
5. Attach your feathers to the top of your mask. You can always draw around these shapes and make more feathers on the spare card left over on page 2.
6. Next cut out your duck beak (d.) and fold the line along the top of the beak. Cut the lines on the side of the beak and fold them slightly. Tape or glue the top of the beak to the the ducks head.
7. Attach string or elastic to the sides of your mask. To do this hold your mask against your face and get someone to measure how much string you'll need.
8. To finish I added some yellow pen marks onto the ducks face to add more depth.
