

*Hi! Welcome to the workshop!*

This is your activity pack:

- Fabric (x3 pieces)
- Paints (x3 colours)
- Paint brushes

You will also need phone/camera to take a photo

Consider these pairs of words:

- **SUNSHINE & JOY**
- **HEALTH & FRIENDSHIP**
- **GROWTH & CARE**

### TASK 1

Interpret each pair of words into a visual design to paint on the fabric. Aim to create 3 pieces. Think about line, shape, pattern and colour. Avoid being too literal

My example:

*I used phrases from ORIKI which are praise names in Yoruba. In the first image in this example the ORIKI was 'AMONISEGUN MAPO' which means 'the one who is all-knowing and has powerful medicine'*

*This was a series of 9 paintings on hessian. All of my designs utilised the oval (face) at the centre. In this example I used the white circles/dots to represent eyes and repeated them beyond the 'face' to symbolise seeing/knowing everything. The parallel lines at the bottom represent vibrations and healing that resonates from the earth.*



## TASK 2

Wear your design as an apron, mask, tie/bib or scarf (or you can ask a friend or family member). Take a photo of each design being worn. Consider your framing shot - do you want full body; portrait; torso?  
Send us your image and we will print it!

### My example:

*I chose to have my friends wear the artwork as aprons and had them photographed as full body.*



## TASK 3

We will print and return your photographs on paper.  
Using the same limited palette, paint the background of your 3 images to make them connect.  
Consider blocks of colour, lines and patterns that run off the background of one image on to the other.

### My example:

*I painted the background red and black at the base and used the white circles/dots from the 'AMONISEGUN MAPO' design to connect the other images.*
