

## WOLF MASK MAKING INSTRUCTIONS



## What you'll need:

Card

Scissors

Pencils, Pens, black sharpie, black biro and paints

Paintbrush

Stapler or string or tape

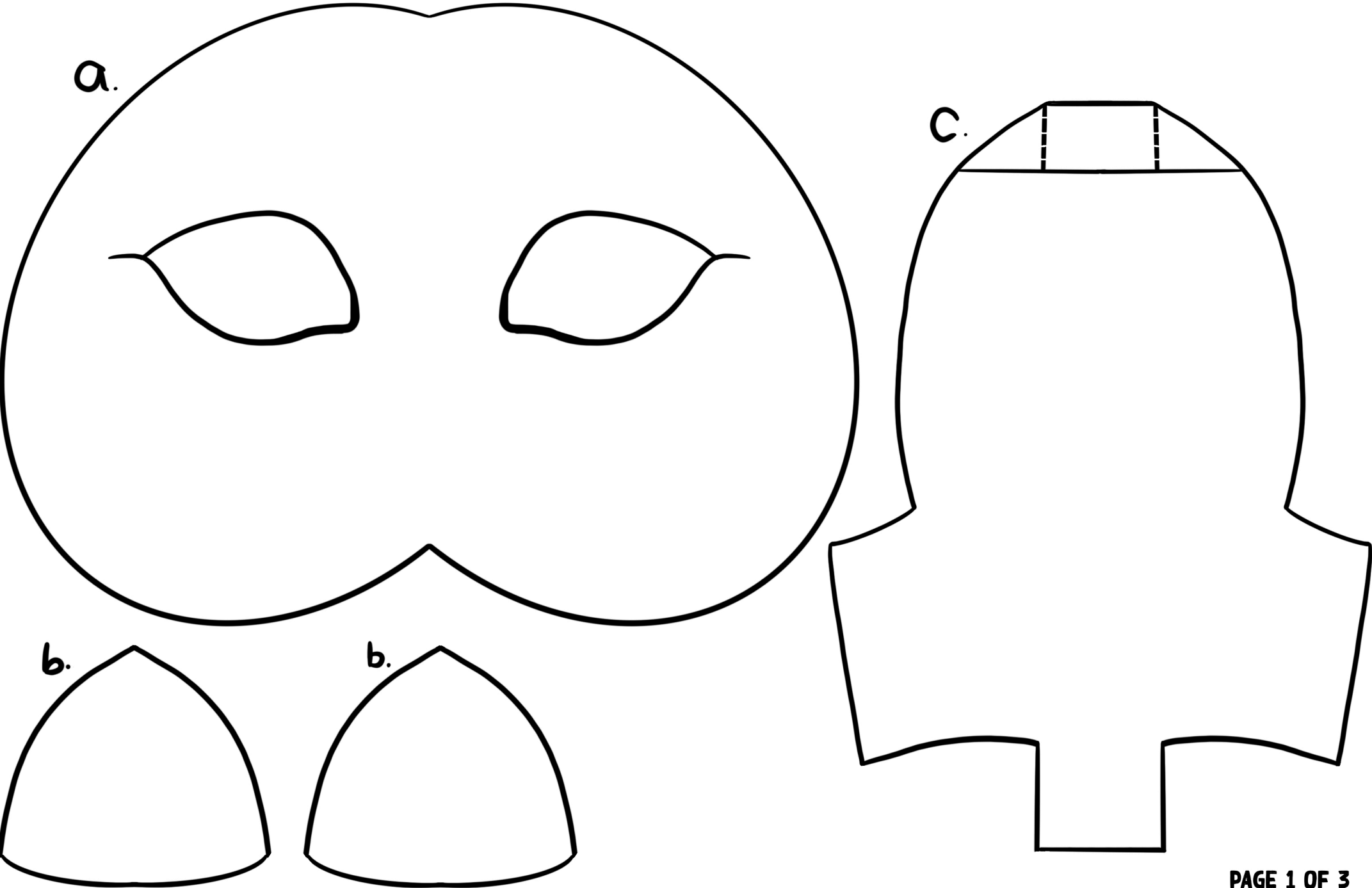
Newspaper

1. Start by colouring in your wolf mask pieces. You can use pencils pens or paint depending on what you have in your home. I've used pencils first by shading in light and dark areas and using different parts of the pencil to create different textures. You can also press harder with your pencil to create darker areas and use the side of your pencil to create a softer feel.
2. When using the paint on top of the pencil marks I used multiple brushes with different brush ends. Try dabbing the brush, using lighter brush strokes with a thinner brush and using the paint really thickly too. You can practise your marks on some scrap paper first.
3. Once you're happy with your layering of pencils and paint and it's dry you can go over any black lines that you might have painted over.
4. Cut out template (a.) Cut out the inside of the eyes too by snipping a little hole in the centre and then cutting around the edge.
5. Next cut out (d.) Then cut along the dotted line then fold your card in slightly. Tape or glue in place.
6. Cut out your nose (f.) stick to the end of the snout.
7. Cut out (d.) and attached to the top of the head in the centre and attach to sides but bend it slightly so it's 3d (see photo below).
8. Next cut out the inside of your wolf ears (b.) and attach them with a bend.
9. Cut out the eyebrows (g.) and attach at just the one point so that they stick up. You can also add some biro strokes to the eyebrows for finer details.
10. Cut out the two parts (e.) and attach at a curve below the eyes.
11. Next you can cut out all of (h.) and (i.). With these parts it's up to you where you attach them. Feel free to be as creative as you like. You can also draw out more to add lots of layers.
12. Now you can introduce another material which is newspaper. Cut out similar shapes to the ones you've just cut out and add these to your mask too. Stick them down at the tip and curl the rest of the shape up with your finger.
13. Attach string or elastic to the sides of your mask. To do this hold your mask against your face and get someone to measure how much string you'll need so you can tie the two pieces of string at the back

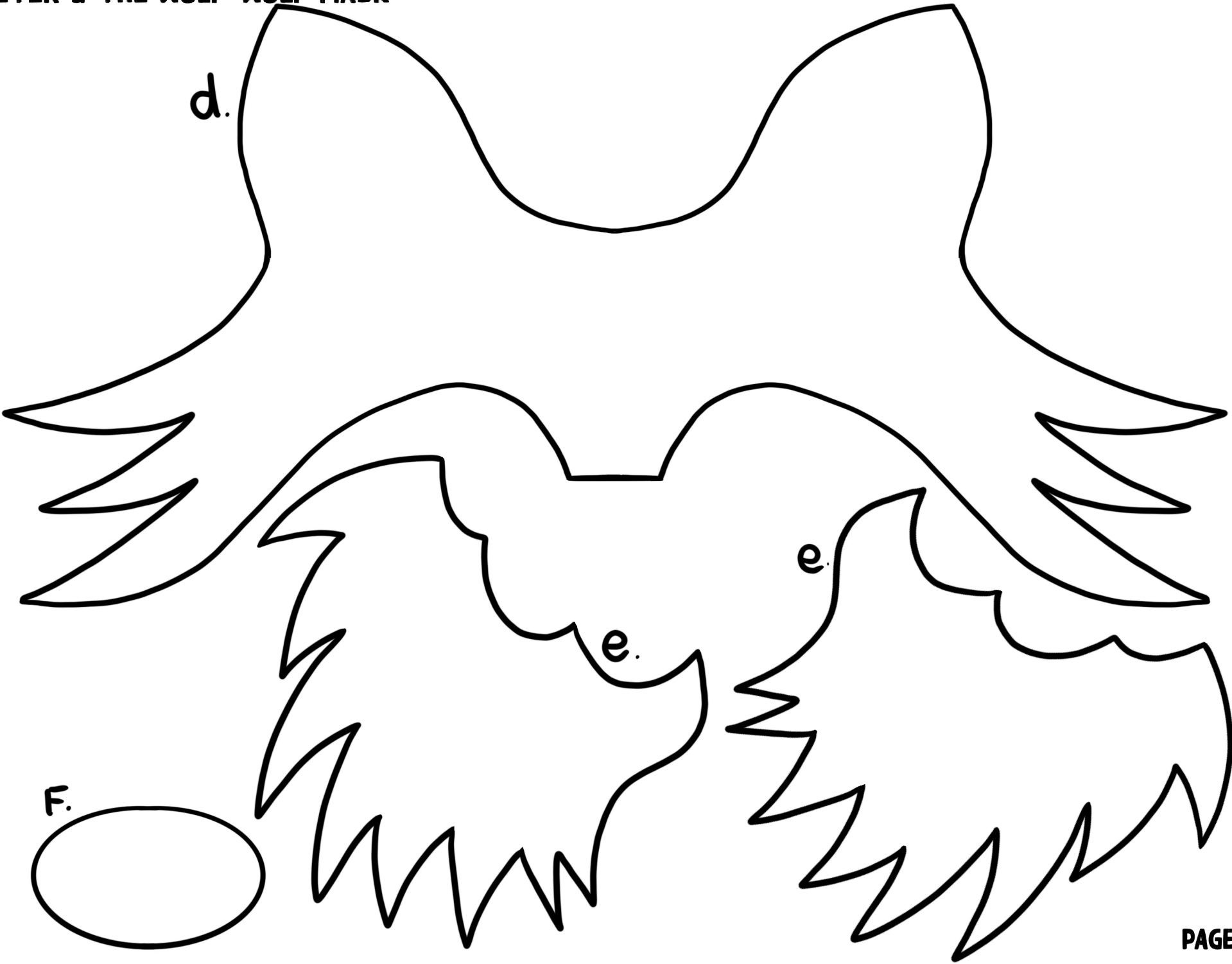
